## Primary survey

ABCDE assessment & stabilisation

### Investigation & Identification

Investigation: ECG, lab, tox screen

(which agent, levels)

Identification: clinical features, history

## Risk assessment

Agent type (immediate/slowrelease), dose, time of ingestion, clinical features, patient features (age, comorbidity)

#### **ADME**

Absorption ↓: e.g. gastric lavage, activated charcoal

Distribution ↓: e.g. Fab-fragments for Digoxine Metabolism △: e.g. N-AC for Paracetamol

Elimination 1: e.g. hemodialysis

# **Therapy**

Resuscitation, antidote, specific therapy

#### **Evaluation**

Monitoring, observation, disposition Screen for child abuse, psychiatric evaluation
